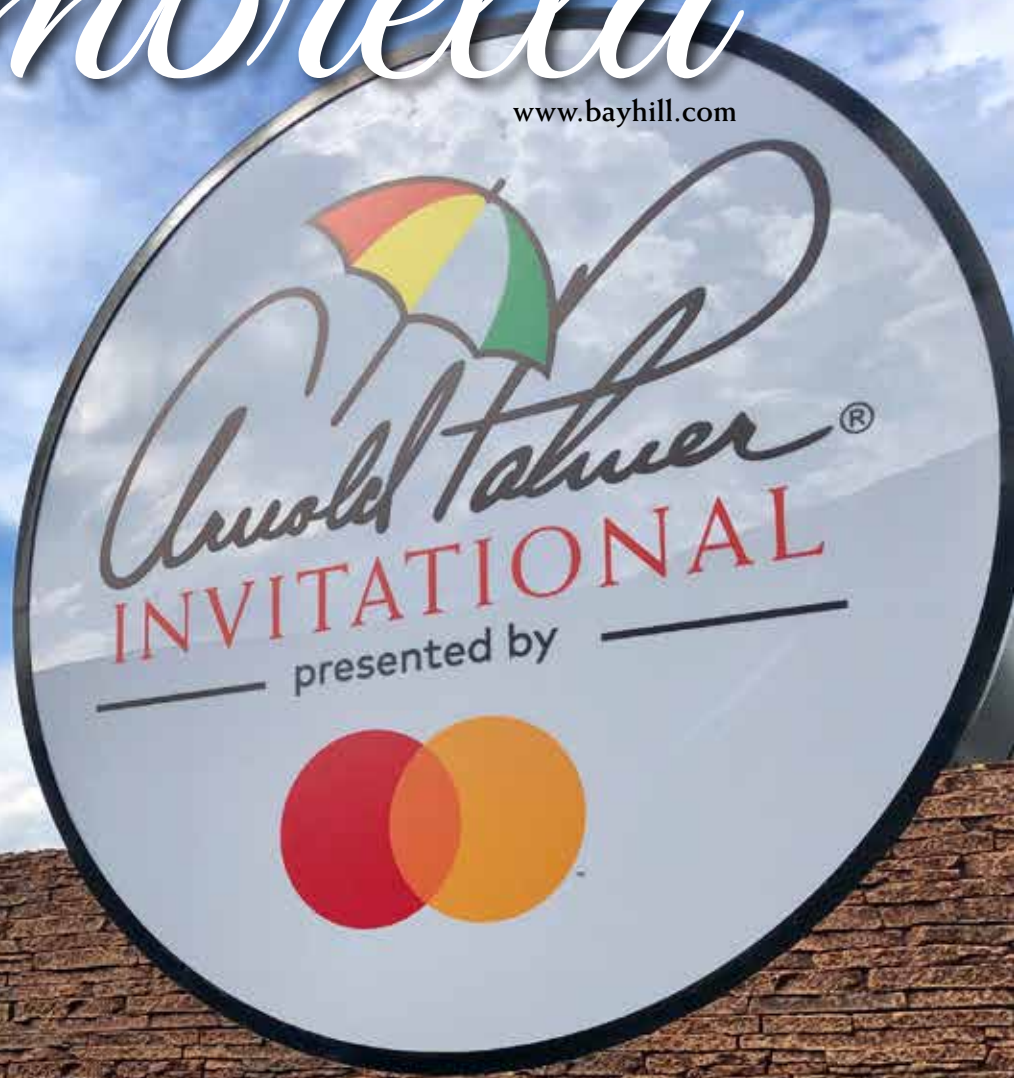

## NEWS FROM *Don*

Francesco Molinari must have been channeling Mr. Palmer when he stepped on to the first tee at Bay Hill Club at 12:05 p.m. on Sunday, March 10. Trailing the leader by five shots with only 18 holes left, on a course considered by most as one of the most superbly conditioned, challenging layouts on the tour, the odds were certainly against the young Italian.

With bold play, Molinari tamed Bay Hill with a scorching 8 under par final round to win by two strokes over Matthew Fitzpatrick. An explanation point was put on his round when he drained a forty-five foot putt on the 18th hole in front of a packed crowd.

Over 145,000 golf fans came out to Bay Hill for the 2019 Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard and millions watched on Golf Channel and NBC. The world's eyes were on Bay Hill.

What does it take to put on a tournament like this? It starts with a cast of 1,500 dedicated volunteers lead by General Chairman John Konicek who worked tirelessly behind the scenes to make the machine run. It was directed by the dedicated staff of the API lead by Marci Doyle. Mix in the vision and drive of Arnold Palmer Enterprises CEO Jon Podany who created the Arnold Palmer Experience this year as a way to bring Mr. Palmer's career to life. It's Cori Britt and the team at API Licensing bringing vibrancy and life to the brands of Arnold Palmer, in clothes (check out the new PUMA gear), AriZona ice tea, Miller Coors Spiked Ice Tea and more. It's Brandon Johnson and Thad Layton of Arnold Palmer Design Company whose Short Game Practice Facility was the toast of the PGA. It's Reade Tilley and Scott Curry, leading a team of public relations professionals from all over the USA to get the right message out to all. And last but not least, it's Director of Grounds Chris Flynn and his incredible crew who made our golf course the real star of the event.

For my part I am blessed with a hard-working and dedicated team who worked all year preparing, and too many hours to count during the week, to execute the plan. My thanks go to all of them for going above and beyond to produce great memories. This year our team was aided by managers from all over the country who came to Bay Hill to support and help during the tournament as a way of honoring the legacy of the Palmer family.

I would be remiss if I didn't thank the Members who selflessly give up their course and club, our neighbors who tolerate the hectic nature of tournament time each year, and of course our ownership who challenge all employees, each day, to do better, to think with creativity, and to find ways to enhance the legacy, values and philanthropy of Arnold and Winnie Palmer for generations of fans and those who will come in the future.

As the sun set over the course on Sunday, it is my hope that Mr. & Mrs. Palmer were looking down at the events of the API from above and smiled.

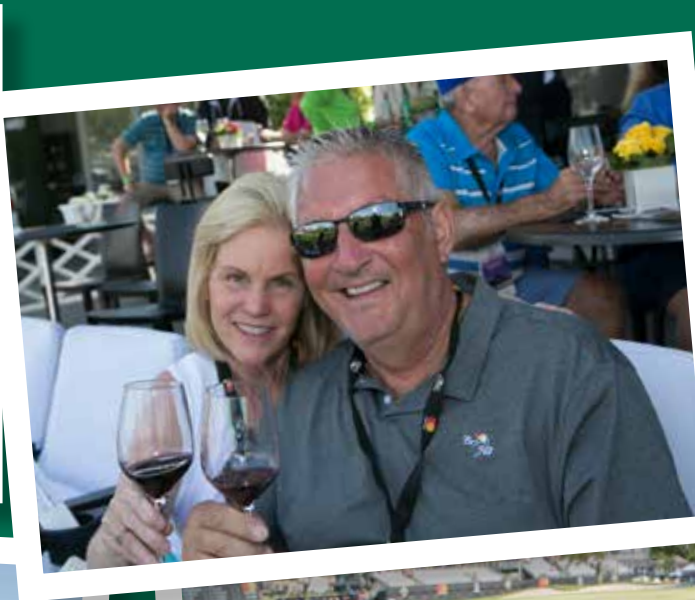

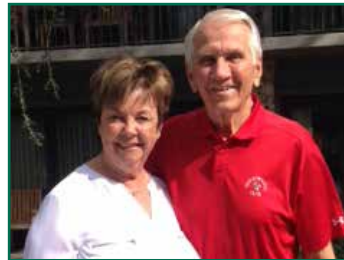
