Please observe  $90^{\circ}$  cart rules – after teeing off drive on the paths until you reach your golf ball, you may then drive to your ball, play your shot, then proceed to the path (unless your cart partner's ball is in close proximity to your last shot). **Fathers and Sons** – be sure to sign up for the 25th Annual Christmas Eve Father-Son. Always a very popular event at the club with 120+ participants in recent years. Gentlemen – you can be the father or the son on your respective team – if you have more than one son, you can play with both.

**CLUB RULE REMINDER:** Due to the increased demand for starting times, the Club's winter season guest policy takes effect on December 1:

#### ACCOMPANIED GUEST PLAY

The fall season brings cooler weather, begins our busy golfing season, and the annual practice of overseeding.

Overseeding - Darned if you do and darned if you don't. If there is ever (by some accounts) an unnecessary task in golf course management that is also by some accounts totally necessary, it's winter overseeding. An agronomic procedure aimed more at wooing winter play than for any meaningful enhancement of turf health.

To call it a purely cosmetic practice would be accurate, but also a little simplistic. For there is the economic viability and impact to our members/ guests during the busy winter season and for the API held in March.

Beyond aesthetics, overseeding does arguably provide better turf conditions during the coldest of periods. If it is unseasonably cold or after a frost – an overseeded course is going to be more attractive and provide better playing conditions (at least in the short term). The decision not to overseed can and will produce golfer complaints since they have been accustomed to overseeded conditions. The main factors would be the lack of lush green color; worn areas especially in high traffic areas, and slow recovery from divot damage.

The key to all of this is the weather. In a normal Central Florida winter – not overseeding will be of minimal impact. But you have to account that in one out of every three or four years we will have an unseasonably cold winter. And you must be quick to react with what the weather deals you. In this event, measures like cart restrictions would need to be quickly taken to protect the turf.

For our situation, overseeding is a must. The only way to ensure great playing conditions during the winter and for the API is to overseed. This is based on the high amount of golf rounds and the excessive use of golf carts all in a time when our bermudagrass is barely growing.

# **IN MEMORIAM**

#### **David Roderick**



David Milton Roderick, 95, died Saturday, October 5, 2019. Mr. Roderick was the former chairman and CEO of U.S. Steel and a Latrobe resident, splitting time between there and Orlando, Fla., where he was a member of the Bay Hill Club for more than 20 years. He joined the Marine Corps at 17, serving

as a platoon sergeant in the Pacific until 1945. Before joining U.S. Steel, he worked for Gulf Oil, the Bessemer & Lake Erie Railroad Co. and the Union Railroad Co. He joined U.S. Steel in 1959 and remained with the company until his retirement in 1989. He represented the steel industry to several U.S. presidents. The David M. Roderick Nature Reserve on Lake Erie is named in his honor, and Mr. Roderick worked with Arnold Palmer to found the Winnie Palmer Nature Reserve at Saint Vincent College. Mr. Roderick and Arnold Palmer were next-door neighbors in Latrobe; he loved to golf at every opportunity. He was an avid Pittsburgh sports fan until the end of his life. Condolences are extended to his children David M. Roderick Jr. and wife Nancy, of Ligonier, Patricia Roderick Morton and husband Thruston, of Charlotte, and Thomas K. Roderick and wife Susan, of Orlando, and their families.


