Nov 14-15: Jack Turner survived a playoff to secure the win in the Boys 16-18 Division of the Florida Junior Tour Championship, carding a 1-over 217 for the two-day championship. In Saturday's first round, the Orlando native posted a 3-over 75 to sit three shots back of the leaders heading into the second round.

He bounced back with a second-round 68 to take the 36-hole lead. Turner used a bogey-free front nine and five birdies on the day to fire the low round of the championship for the Boys 16-18 Division.

Turner, who won the Boys' Junior 13-15 Championship title in July, got off to a quick start in the final round with a birdie on the second. He ran into some trouble on the sixth, finishing with a double bogey, and made the turn at 1-over for the day.

The 2023 graduate carded a 1-over back nine to finish the day in a tie for first place with Nicholas Prieto at 1-over 217. Prieto rolled in a birdie on the 17th to move to the top of the leaderboard with Turner. The Miami native posted a 1-under 71 in the final round, the low round of day in the Boys 16-18 Division.

Turner secured the victory with a par on the second playoff hole. Prieto took a runner-up finish, while Xirong Cheng finished one shot back in third place at 2-over 218. Jonah Winter and Logan Hunter tied for fourth at 5-over 221.

Golf Cart Usage: We will be lifting the "cart path only" restrictions in early December, depending upon how well the rye grass is filling in. I know it seemed like this time would never come, so let's enjoy it and do our best to use the golf carts responsibly. Please observe 90° cart rules – after teeing off drive on the paths until you reach your golf ball, you may then drive to your ball, play your shot, then proceed to the path (unless your cart partner's ball is in close proximity to your last shot).

Fathers and Sons – be sure to sign up for the Christmas Eve Father-Son. Always a very popular event at the club with 120+ participants in recent years. This year's event will be slightly different with an early double tee start - limited to the first 52 Father-Son teams.

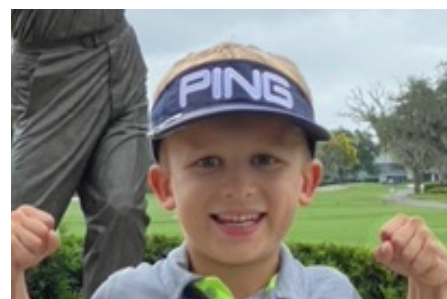
