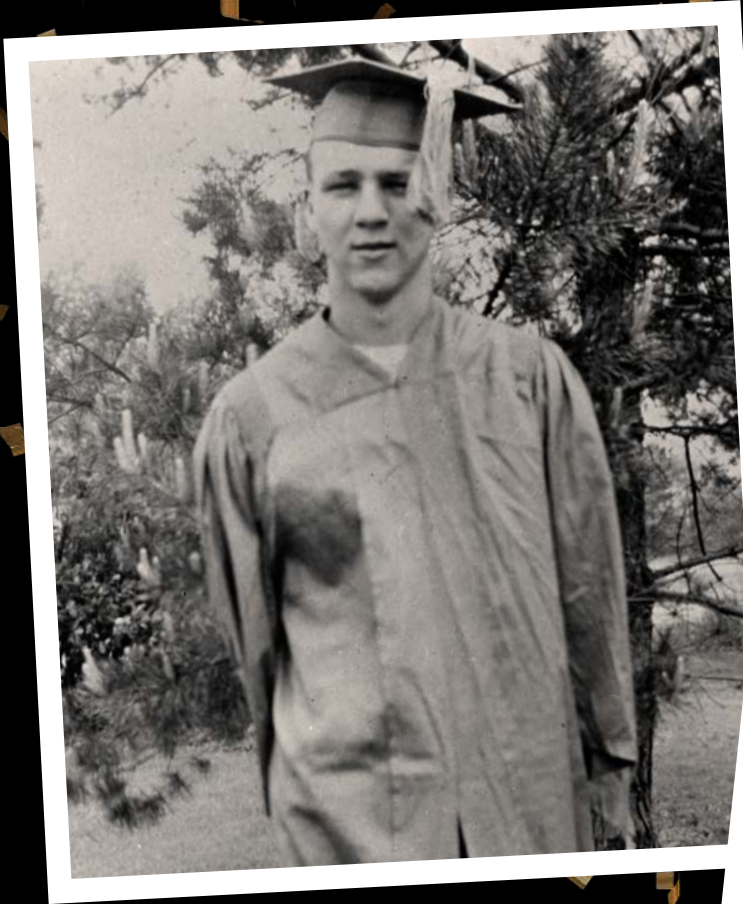

- Cover your mouth when coughing or sneezing

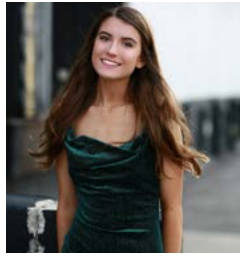

What an amazing 2 month stretch for aces – the most I have seen in 20+ years!!



**March 19: Palmer Haynes** - #7 with his 4-hybrid from 165 yards. It was Palmer's 2nd lifetime ace.



**April 24: Pete Doyle** - #2 with his 4-iron from 210 yards. It was Pete's first lifetime ace.



**March 28: Ted Wilson** - #2 with his 6-iron from 185 yards. It was his 5th lifetime hole-in-one (3 on hole #2 and 2 on hole #17). He cleared the Shootout Hole-in-One pool for the first time in over 2 years.



**May 19: Linda Schumacher** - #2 Charger with her PW from 74 yards. It was Linda's first lifetime ace and matched her mother's (Kay Yurko) feat 24 years earlier.

**April 7: Lauro DeLuca** - #7 Charger with his 6-iron from 157 yards. He was having a playing lesson with Tom Garner! It was his 5th lifetime HIO, first at Bay Hill (and first in nearly 20 years).



**May 26: Bob Dawsey** - #14 with his 7-iron from 164 yards. It was Bob's 3rd lifetime ace but 1st at Bay Hill.

**April 14: Don Howard** - #7 with his 7-iron from 153 yards. It was Don's 2nd lifetime ace (both on the same hole).

## HONORABLE MENTION:

**April 14: Matt Ouimet** made a heck of a 3 on hole #17. In the process of working on some suggestions from John O'Leary during their playing lesson, Matt hit his tee shot in the water. He teed up another ball and proceeded to knock it in the hole – 158 yards with his 5-hybrid!
